Project 1 Submission Guidelines

Project Statement

Provide a 300-word description of your project describing you project and explaining visual documentation (representative image and video) in PDF format. This description must explain your concept, collaborative development and how it relates to relevant research in the field. Your project statement can also contain additional images (along with the Representative Image). Please see the examples in the zip folder for what we are expecting, although you aren't required to include an artist statement (some of these example write-ups include both the project statement and the artist's bio, but we just want your project statement). You must also include an additional paragraph explaining who was responsible for each aspect of the project.

Representative Image

You must provide one file that is the main image that represents your project. This file must be a high-resolution image in JPEG, PNG, or TIFF format. Select an uncompressed image file with the highest detail possible. DO NOT artificially manipulate the size of your image in a photo-editing software as that will not improve the resolution.

Min pixel dimensions 3000 x 2300 pixels. Feel free to use images from the review.

Video Documentation

You must also include a short video of your project in .mp4 or .mov format. Videos should be between 1 minute and 2 minutes long (including any text for the titles, explanations, and credits) and must be high resolution HD quality. If the video has an audio component, provide a credit for the audio composer in credits.

Upload all documentation (pdf, image, video) to class folder on the Drive in a single .zip folder for each team project.
