PROJECT STATEMENT

My project aims to represent Chicago's air quality in different communites based on research done by the NRDC (Natural Resources Defesense Council) and by the City of Chicago's Air Quality and Health Report. The purpose of my project is to bring awareness of this inequality, and to bring change to achieve environmental justice to the city of Chicago through the use of typography in virtual reality.

Air quality in Chicago has been getting worse over the years, and recently it recorded the worst unhealthy air streak in IO years. One of the main issues is that air quality varies throught the city, where low-income and people of color are the most vunarable groups to air pollution and it's health issues.


VR SCENE

In my VR scene, the first thing that the user will see is a birds eye view of the map of Chicago, where it shows air quality represented in areas by 3 different colors, red as being the areas most vunarable and affected by air pollution, orange representing moderately affected areas, and two shades of green representing the least affected areas having the healthiest air quality.

INTERACTIONS

After seeing the map, the user will land on the map, and be able to walk through Chicago's areas. One of the interactions is when the user walks through the area text name, a text box will pop up providing information of that area. The second interaction is audio, as the user walks through the areas, sounds associated with that area will play. The final interaction is the user can press key words based on the color of the area the user is standing on to show air pollution particles.
