

Triage When there is no time to spare.

Triage is a volunteer medical emergency application that allows off-duty medical professionals to respond to severe 911 calls on the fly. Triage allows the professional to serve as a buffer zone in situations where they might arrive before the ambulance does.



Objectives

To create an application that can really make a difference anywhere in the world.

To increase response time for victoms who need it when the ambulance is unable to.

To allow for professionals to give back to the community at times when they are comfortable.

To set-up a framework that can serve as an example of how emergency procedures may be re-examined with the advent of new technologies.



Issue at hand

"There is no nationwide standard for measuring emergency response times.

A USA TODAY study of the 50 biggest U.S. cities found that **most report only the slice of the response that looks most favorable: the time it takes for the emergency crew to drive to the scene.** On many emergency runs, that is just a fraction of the time that passes between the call for help and the arrival of rescuers.

Yet most cities base quality-control decisions on these official response times, which are misleading and incomplete. As a result, people die, and attempts to improve survival rates fail.

More than 1,000 "saveable" lives are lost needlessly each year in the nation's biggest cities because of inefficiencies in the cities' emergency medical systems, USA TODAY's investigation found, and at the root of these inefficiencies in many cases is the simple matter of counting seconds."

Concept

Create an application that pools resources from volunteer medical professionals.

Refined

Synchronize the warning system with current 911 infastructure (Conceptually) Embedd an agreement document within app to help protect volunteers from future legal issues



Features

911 forwarding system that automatically synchronizes to application.

Map service integration that compares volunteers position according to call at hand. (Google Maps, Bing, Apple's TomTom Maps)

Integration of current iPhone functions and features to allow for a more efficient, seamless, and intuitive interation.

One legible typeface with minimal amount of variation






