

 Currently all OB Services policies, guidelines and protocols are housed via the intranet homepage




- Documents are accessible via desktop or via mobile phone

 - Making the app secure so it is only accessible to UI Health OB staff
 - Making the app administratively efficient so that updating material isn't cumbersome
